## Prayer Doll

Prayer Dolls ~ sweet little bead embellished fabric dolls ~ are thought to bring love, joy, good health, and prosperity to their owners. You can give one to a friend, celebrate an occasion, put one on your Christmas tree, or send one as a "get well angel." When you make a prayer doll, whether for yourself, or as a gift, the idea is to be mindful, or prayerful, of her purpose as you stitch her seams and embellish her with carefully chosen beads. Deb and her daughters recently made 7 prayer dolls in purple for family members who are navigating the aftermath of Domestic Violence.

Materials will include fabric & stuffing to make one doll, a variety of beads, charms, and embellishments, etc. and the Spirit Dolls booklet by Robin Atkins, which includes 3 pattern variations, instructions and tips for designing and creating your own unique prayer dolls. An awareness ribbon charm (*cancer, autism, patriotic, domestic violence, etc.*) will also be included. You may also bring your own beads.

**Wool Felt Candle/Mug Mat**

Take one adorable candle mat, add a votive candleholder and candle...or a coffee mug or tea cup...and you have the perfect gift for a special teacher, or a good friend. Cut out the wool shapes using freezer paper templates, and stitch the pieces to the foundation with a blanket stitch. Some designs add beads for embellishment. Patterns available for year round decorating/giving, including Happy Birthday!

Have you ever wanted to try canvaswork, but the size of the piece or expense of materials changed your mind? This small piece will introduce you to some of the basics of canvaswork, without a lot of expense or complexity. The model is shown worked on 18 ct. white mono canvas, but a larger count will work equally well. The design uses just 2 colors of cotton floss and 1 color of #8 pearl cotton. Carol Toll will guide you through this two hour class. 10 am - Noon (You are welcome to stay for the afternoon to make a second one!)
